Ranch House Kids VBS will begin and end each day with everyone together in worship. The children will be separated into appropriate age groups and will rotate with their age group through several sites each day: Craft Corral, Open Range Recreation, Saddle Up Missions, and Campfire Sing-Along. They will learn about the story in each activity site as their daily adventures unfold!

The best part of each day at the Circle G Ranch will be when your children *knock* and the door to a relationship with God will open. In the most important part of their VBS experience, the Open Door Adventure, the kids will step into the Bible story and step closer in their relationship with God. Each story is designed to invite your children right into the Bible story to become part of each adventure. **Friday**—Believe In Jesus—Invitation at the Open Door—Acts 16:25-34
