BASKETBALL PROGRAM SITE MANAGER NEEDED St. Paul UMC is looking for a **Basketball Program Site Manager** to work 8 Saturdays in January and February. The Manager will be required to be at the church and with the doors unlocked at 8:30am each Saturday morning, at 7:30am on Photo Day and remain until 6:00pm to lock and secure the building. This person will be responsible for court set-up before the games, goals in place, balls ready, score keepers table set-up, and chairs for spectators. They will be responsible for the church throughout the day, including gym restrooms kept neat and orderly. At the end of the day they will be responsible for storing goals, balls, chairs, clean-up and sweeping the gym, and making sure all doors are locked and secure. During the day the site manager will act as greeter and liaison between parents, coach's, referees & teams at St. Paul. The Manager will work closely with the referees to ensure games start on time, remain on schedule throughout the day, and all games are conducted in a professional and peaceful manner conducive to the programs mission for children. St. Paul Information sheets will be provided but knowledge of programs and welcoming personality will be expected. The Manager will maintain a communication log in the gym for comments, incidents and concerns during games and practices and constant communication with the program director is expected. Site Manager will be required to attend the Coach's Safety Class and Pass a Criminal Back Ground Check.
