HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE FOR SENIORS Beginning in November, in conjunction with the Fulton Atlanta Community Action Authority (FACAA) and the Low income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), the St. Paul Golden Age Center will begin accepting applications for a grant to help low income seniors with their heating bill. FACAA receives federal funding to assist eligible households in Fulton County with a one-time yearly grant of up to \$350 to supplement the cost of utility services for the primary source of heating homes. Seniors must be at least 65 years of age, live in Fulton County, and meet certain income guidelines. If you want more information about this assistance, please contact Becky Wellman at 404 688-7501.
